## Requirements:

The summer camp is open to children ages 2 years to 6 years who are potty trained. Campers need to be registered and have a copy of their birth certificate and medical forms before camp begins. Updated medical forms can be obtained from your child's pediatrician or from <http://www.vdh.virginia.gov/school-age-health-and-forms/school-health-forms-and-action-plans/>. Remember that Part 1, Health Information Form is completed by the parent. For current students and past students, we have medical forms and birth certificates on file. We have only 15 slots available for each session. A minimum of 4 kids must be registered by the Friday before each session in order to have camp that week. Session fees are nonrefundable except in the event of cancellation by staff. Text ahead to find out if a drop-in slot is available. ## Camp Information

### **Clothing:**

Proper dress is required. Children should not wear sandals or flip flops, please. They can fall when running in these and spend too much time trying to get the sand and mulch out of their toes. We suggest tennis shoes and socks.

### **Sunscreen and Bug Spray:**

The teachers cannot apply sunscreen or bug spray. We recommend applying it to your child before coming to camp.

### **Lunch:**

Children will need a lunch each day. We will provide cold water.

### **Personal Care:**

All children in summer camp must be potty trained. Children should wear clothing that can easily be removed when going to the restroom. Please send in a change of clothes labeled with their name in a labeled zip lock bag, just in case of an accident. In the case of illness or accidents, we will follow the same procedures that we did during the school year.

### **Medical:**

Children will not be permitted at our school with any of the following conditions:

1. Fever of 100 degrees under arm (auxiliary) or higher, and if they also have one or more of the following: diarrhea, earache, shows signs of irritability or confusion, sore throat, rash within a 24 hour period.
2. Vomiting on two or more occasions within the past 24 hours.
3. Diarrhea – three or more watery stools in a 24-hour period.
4. Draining rash or undiagnosed rash lasting over a 24-hour period.
5. Eye discharge or pink eye. Children can be readmitted after medical diagnosis to rule out bacterial or viral infection, or 24 hours on antibiotic treatment.
6. Fatigue that prevents participation in regular activities.
7. Open oozing sores and scabs, unless properly covered and 24 hours on antibiotic treatment.
8. Head lice – until treatment is effective and a follow-up check has been made by school personnel.

In the case of minor injury or accident, the staff will administer basic first aid. All injuries or illnesses not requiring immediate parental notification will be documented and reported to parents when the child is picked up at the end of the day. In case of medical injury or illness requiring immediate professional care (emergency), the staff will call 911, giving location and nature of emergency. As appropriate, the staff will administer CPR or first aid measures. Parents will be notified immediately. If parents are unavailable, those individuals designated as emergency phone contacts will be notified.

### **Drop Off & Pick Up**

Children will only be released to an authorized adult with proper identification. All children must be picked up at their classroom door on time to ensure a safe dismissal. Please initial the sign in/out book as you pick or drop off your child.
